Objective	The Laundry Attendant is responsible for the efficient and hygienic processing of all laundry and linen within the lodge. The role ensures that guest rooms, dining areas, and staff uniforms are supplied with clean, well-presented linen always.
Key Areas	1. Laundry Operations - Sort, wash, dry, fold, and iron linen, towels, and guest clothing according to established procedures. - Operate washing machines, dryers, irons, and other laundry equipment safely and efficiently. - Ensure proper handling of delicate and specialty fabrics. 2. Linen & Inventory Management - Maintain adequate stock of clean linen, towels, and uniforms. - Track and report linen usage and inventory levels. - Assist with receiving, storing, and issuing linen supplies. 3. Cleanliness & Hygiene - Maintain cleanliness and order in the laundry area at all times. - Follow health, safety, and hygiene regulations. - Dispose of laundry chemicals safely and responsibly. 4. Guest & Staff Support - Assist with pressing or special laundry requests from guests or staff. - Handle guest garments with care and return items promptly. - Respond courteously to any requests related to laundry services. 5. Maintenance & Reporting - Report faulty machines, equipment, or maintenance issues to management. - Ensure laundry equipment is kept clean and in good working condition. - Maintain records of laundry activities as required.
